

The Following Questions will help you in writing your daily log and final paper. These are only suggestions.

The following written elements will be submitted to your faculty internship supervisor. You will discuss with your supervisor the preferred format, time line and method of submission.

Completed daily log of all internship activities and reflection. Detailed descriptions are required. Sample Questions to answer

1. What do you do on a typical day at your placement?
2. What is the most difficult part of your work?
3. What was the best thing that happened this week – something you said or did, an insight, or a goal that was accomplished?
4. Are you applying what you learned in the classroom to the work? What? How?
5. Did you develop or begin to develop a new skill? Explain.

Final paper 5-10 pages in length. Sample Questions might include:

1. How has your work changed since you first began there (different activities, more or less responsibility, etc.)
2. If you could go back to the first day of this program, what would you do differently?
3. If you were in charge of the place where you work, what would you do to improve it?
4. What has happened that made you feel you would (or would not) like to do this as a career?
5. If you could sum up the most important thing you take with you from this experience, it is ... The most important thing you have brought to your placement situation is
