

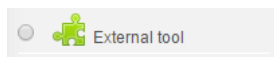
# Adding a Zoom Meeting Area to a Moodle Course



Zoom web based conferencing system allows you to add a virtual meeting room to any of your Moodle courses. You can use this to meet with your students virtually for a formal class, a one-on-one meeting, or for small group work. This stable link will be available to you and your students throughout your course for as many meetings as you need to have. The instructor is automatically the meeting host and can meet and record for up to 40 minutes at a time with your basic account.

**Important:** All faculty must register their account at [Albright.zoom.us](https://Albright.zoom.us) prior to using this service for the first time. Use your Albright login credentials to create the account. You can then immediately logout and follow the steps below to add a Zoom meeting room to any Moodle course.

1. Go to your course and find the section where the meeting link should appear

2. Choose External Tool and click Add



3. Give the Online Meeting room a name and choose Zoom from External Tool Type drop down menu

4. Hit Save and return to course.

## To Launch a Meeting

5. Click the Zoom activity to start a meeting  
Depending on what browser you use, you may be prompted to launch the Zoom Meetings application. When prompted, press OK or Launch Activity. There may be a box to check so your choice is remembered for future meetings.
6. Choose Join Audio by Computer and make sure your camera and microphone are plugged in. Note that using video is optional – you can just use this for audio calls too.

## Other Information:

- Press Record to record the meeting locally. This will save to your computer as an mp4 after the meeting ends. You can upload the recording to your course using Kaltura.
- Students can use this meeting room without you but they may not record their meetings as they are not hosts.
- This link can be used as many times as you wish to hold meetings.
- Students will be prompted to enter their name. It will automatically pick up your name as you are the meeting host.
- Zoom is accessible on MacOS, Windows, iOS, and Android mobile devices. Additionally, Zoom can be used with conventional phone lines for audio conferencing.
- [Albright.zoom.us](http://Albright.zoom.us) is another way for you and your students to use Zoom. Anyone on campus can create a basic account on this site and create scheduled meetings outside of Moodle.
